STAY POSITIVE & NEUTRAL
 Promote awareness
 Do not endorse candidates

- BE GRACIOUS
 Thank participating candidates
- REPEAT, RETWEET, REPLY
 Stay engaged with other users
- FOCUS ON THE OUTCOME
 An informed, activated electorate





Extra Credit: After the election

Invite elected officials to special events

- Ask student to give a behind-the-scenes tour
- Share how students benefited by participating in this exhibit/performance
- Take pictures of elected officials at student events to be included in news articles

Build relationships

- Take a school board member to coffee
- Keep them updated on arts education events happening in your school district
- Ask them for advice on how to increase arts education offerings in the school district


